More Collective hopes to release a line of 15 shirts every 6 months. Submissions are open to all artists residing in Baltimore.

Here are some quick FAQ's (*also found on our website*)

Why are we doing this?

We like printing shirts. We also like printing nice designs on shirts. When we thought of how to combine our two interests we thought about the amazing pool of talent in and around Baltimore right now. Why not offer a way for us to do what we enjoy and help local artists promote themselves and make a little money on the side?

Why Baltimore themed?

More Collective runs on an on-going (and changing) theme system. The one major thing that connects all the various styles of designs together is this single theme. Since we are trying to work with Baltimore artists and the community, why not start with Baltimore as our theme. We are not looking for some touristy "Visit Baltimore, Eat Crabs" shirt but simply something related in some way to Baltimore. The relation can be abstract or literal, for example, you could submit a design that has a pattern from a building you found walking down Howard street. The idea is that we have a group of shirts that reflects the city and reflects the diversity within the various visual styles of the artists residing here.

How does this benefit me?

Well first off, every shirt that is sold includes some form of collateral that contains the designing artists name and contact information allowing people who enjoy a design to know just who created it and how to get a hold of them. Also 12% of the total of each sale goes straight to the artist, understand that the printing and purchasing of the shirt must be accounted for. Additionally the artist retains ALL property and intellectual rights to there designs. We are not buying the designs but simply offering a means for them to have their work promoted and produced on t-shirts.

PRINTING AND DESIGN PARAMETERS

When submitting your design, please consider the following:

- *We have the ability to print up to 6 spot colors.*
- *For photographs we can use 4-color process to reproduce these.*
- *Our max print size is 16x16.5 in.*
- *We CAN print over the collar and other seams.*

ARTIST AGREEMENT

This is a contract between More Collective and _____, who will be referred to herein as the artist.

More Collective will be accepting submissions of artwork (graphic design, photographs, drawings and paintings) with a Baltimore theme.

All submitted artwork will be reviewed and if artwork is selected, the following will apply.

The artist gives More Collective the right to use the artwork to be sold on printed apparel and other printed goods.

The artwork can also be used in other forms of print such as, but not limited to advertisement.

The artist's percentage of each garment sold with the design created by that artist is 12% of the sold price.

Typical pricing for each shirt would be \$15 at festivals and \$18 online. More Collective has the right to adjust pricing for any reason.

The artist will receive payment of their percentage in a timely manner after the end of each month.

More Collective will keep record of shirts sold which can be viewed upon the artists request.

At any given time, More Collective has the right to sell or not sell a product for any reason.

Permission to use trademarked logos or images will be the responsibility of the artist.

Although artwork will be treated with respect to its original form, More Collective has the right to manipulate artwork to fit within our printing parameters i.e. resizing. (See below for printing parameters)

The artist may supply business cards and promotional materials to be handed out in addition to the information More Collective provides.

The artist retains all copyright, ownership and intellectual properties to their artwork.

The artist shall receive a copy of finished product in their requested size.

The artist's name, contact info and other requested information shall be displayed on the website as to give full credit to the work.
